Notice The Surrey County Council D384 Mid Street, Nutfield Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

Surrey County Council propose to make the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of D384 Mid Street, Nutfield. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closures will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians will be maintained at all times under direction of operatives on site. Access for emergency services, residents, businesses, cyclists and equestrians will be maintained to the point of closure via the vehicular diversion route: - Mid Street, Sandy Lane, Bower Hill Lane and Kings Cross Lane.
